Entrance Requirements	3 years old and up * Please make sure your child is toilet-trained before coming to school (we can also accept children a little younger than 3 years old on a case-by-case basis)
Hours of Operation, Student Schedules	Monday ~ Friday, 9:00AM ~ 3:00PM (doors open 8:50) * Families can choose 3, 4 or 5 days of attendance per week (subject to availability) * 3 day schedules are: Tue-Thr-Fri for children who are 3 yrs old on or before Sept 1 2022, Mon-Wed-Fri for children who are 4 yrs old on or before Sept 1 2022 * 4 day schedules are: Mondays through Thursdays
